

SUMMARY OF TAPE E-102 INTERVIEW WITH HILDA ELMGREEN

March 30, 1977

Mrs. Elmgreen was born in Idaho Springs and attended school there until her parents, Belle and Peter Hopper, moved to the Evergreen area in 1906. Hilda was the only girl out of seven children. She was 16 and had completed eighth grade. Socializing for young people involved going to the Grange Hall every two weeks for card parties and dancing. Local musicians supplied music on violins and auto harps.

She married Arthur Elmgreen in 1917. Mr. Elmgreen was the only boy in his family.
