Dora Granzella Williams was born in the Granzella homestead. She was one of seven siblings born to an Italian immigrant. In this tape, however, she talks more of the maternal side of her family. Her grandfather was Louis Francis Ramboz, who was Paris, France. Although her grandfather died when she was a young child, Dora has many memories from visiting him. His first wife was from England. Her grandfather had whiskers and smoked a pipe.

The development of Aspen Park is discussed. The Danforth family owned 320 acres originally. Neighbors would go to the Danforth house for dancing and holiday socials when Dora was in her teens. The Vinette family lived in a large house that also hosted dances. Dora tells a story about the Vinette family house being haunted. Memories also include the Legault family and going to school in a log cabin in Conifer.
